- Have a range of case studies so that appropriate ones can be chosen for the topics tested
- Ensure that each case study used is at the correct scale eg urban area or country The syllabus identifies the scale required for each case study
- Avoid writing a long introduction to any question at the expense of answering it in detail

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GEOGRAPHY - Xtreme

Whilst many excellent case studies were seen some candidates are learning case studies from previous mark schemes and trying to use them regardless of the question is set on that topic This is not good practice as it is not conducive to the candidates' understanding of the geography
